

ADMISSION CRITERIA

Double Master's degree University of Pavia, UNIPV
& University of Clermont Auvergne, UCA

Students may apply to either university, with the same admission criteria:
Each university admits up to five candidates to this programme per academic year.
Candidates to join this programme must be officially admitted to either:

- Master mention Economie du Développement (**UCA, 120 ECTS**)
- Master MEFI (**UNIPV, 120 ECTS**)

UCA students will apply for one of the four proposed streams (Développement Durable, Finances Publiques, Economie de la santé, Economie Territoriale) on one hand, and send their application file to the double degree to the International Relations Office at the school of economics on the other hand.

Students have access to the double degree programme after obtaining the Bachelor's degree (180 ECTS at the start of the programme or equivalent if obtained out of Europe).
Further admission criteria:

- At least 60 ECTS (or equivalent) in economics, and 30 ECTS (or equivalent) in Development Economics, Economic theory or Agricultural economics during their bachelor's degree.
- The B2 level in English and French languages, proved with a score (IELTS, TOEFL, TOEIC, Cambridge...for English; TCF, DELF, DALF...for French) or nationality. Previous graduation in English or French is also sufficient.

Students enrolled in the double degree programme will benefit from Erasmus scholarship during their mobility in the partner university.
