

## The grading system

ECTS Scale	Definition	Percentage of successful students normally achieving the grade	UCA grades equivalents
<b>A</b>	<b>EXCELLENT</b> - Outstanding performance with only minor errors	0.27%	<b>16 to 20</b>
<b>B</b>	<b>VERY GOOD</b> – above the average standard but with some errors	4.16%	<b>14 to 15.99</b>
<b>C</b>	<b>GOOD</b> – generally sound work with a number of notable errors	14%	<b>13 to 13.99</b>
<b>D</b>	<b>SATISFACTORY</b> - fair but with significant shortcomings	37.67%	<b>11 to 12.99</b>
<b>E</b>	<b>SUFFICIENT</b> – performance meets the minimum criteria	15.30%	<b>10 to 10.99</b>
<b>FX</b>	<b>FAIL</b> – some more work required before the credit can be awarded	7.78%	<b>8 to 9.99</b>
<b>F</b>	<b>FAIL</b> - Considerable further work is required	20.82%	<b>0 to 7.99</b>
